Contractions

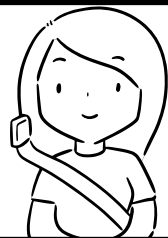
A contraction is a word made by putting two words together. Contractions always have an apostrophe.

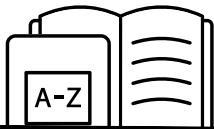
you are = you're
