Amy 	He 

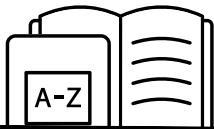
Possessive Nouns and Pronouns

We use possessive nouns & possessive pronouns to show that something belongs to someone.

We turn a regular noun into a possessive noun by adding **'s**.

Her, his, its, our, their, my, & your
are all possessive pronouns.

Possessive Noun	Possessive Pronoun
John's tie 	Her glasses

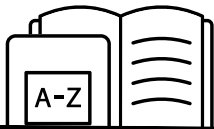
