TYPES OF SENTENCES

What is a Sentence?

A sentence is a group of words that tells a complete thought that makes sense. A sentence always **begins with a capital letter** and **ends with a punctuation** mark.

There are two types of sentences:

A **question** is a sentence that asks a question.
A **statement** is a sentence that tells something.

Statement

Let's go to the park.

Question

Why are you laughing?

Punctuations Marks go at the end of the sentences.

They help us figure out if a sentence is a question or a statement.
A sentence without punctuation is an **incomplete sentence**.

The Period

We use this at the end of a sentence that is a statement.

The Question Mark

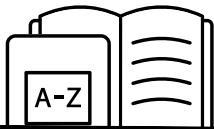
We use this at the end of a sentence that is a question.

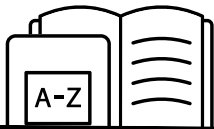

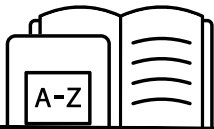

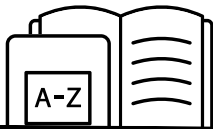
