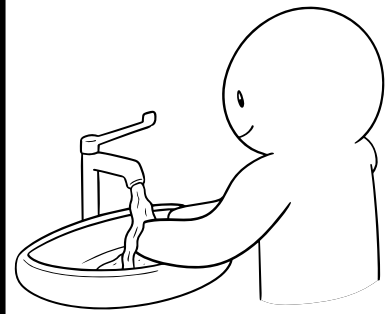
IRREGULAR VERBS

Past Tense Verbs

Verbs tell what someone is doing. We turn regular verbs into past tense by adding the letters **-ed**.

Example:

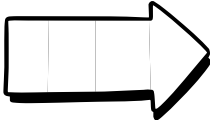
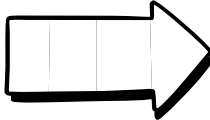
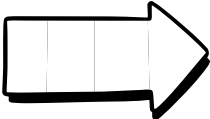
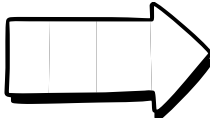
Billy washed his hands before he ate.

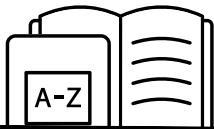


Irregular Verbs

Irregular verbs are different because we can't use the letters -ed to turn them into past tense verbs.

There are two kinds of irregular verbs, **words that don't change** and **words that change without adding the letters -ed**.

Words That Don't Change	Words That Change Without -ed
read  read	tear  tore
quit  quit	begin  began
