Acrostic Poems

Acrostic poems are poems where the topic is one word written vertically.

Example:

Could be winter weather.
Or a stormy night.
Lots of snow sometimes.
Don't forget your coat!



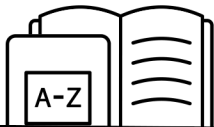
Haiku Poems

A haiku is a traditional form of Japanese poetry. Haikus don't usually rhyme. Haikus have **three lines**. The first sentence has **five syllables**, the second sentence has **seven syllables**, and the third sentence has **five syllables**.

Example:

This is my best friend. (5 syllables)
Her name is Annabelle Fox. (7 syllables)
Her name is pretty. (5 syllables)
