Figurative Language

Figurative language is when we use words in that way that is **not literal**.

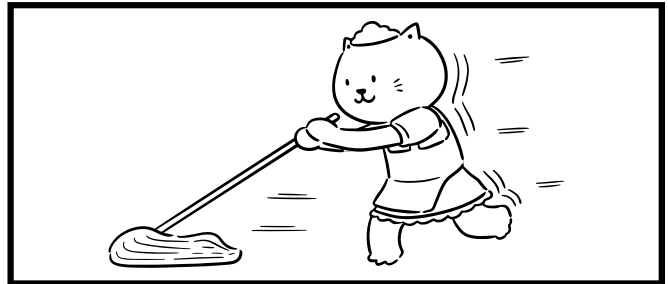
For example, if someone says: "You've been a busy bee."

They are not literally saying that you are bee!

They are saying that you are hardworking.

They're using figurative language to say how hardworking you are.

**You've been a
busy bee.**



Alliteration

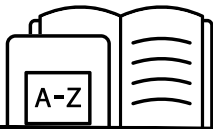
Alliteration is when two or more words in a sentence have the same beginning sound.

Example: "Happy Helen hopped here."

Assonance

Assonance is the repetition of vowel sounds in a sentence.

Example: "Deep sleep."

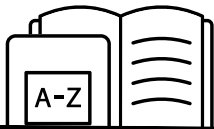

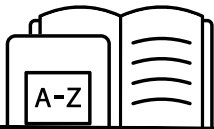

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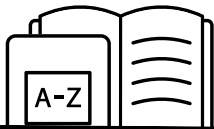
