The **subject** of a sentence tells who or what the sentence is about.

What is a predicate?

The **predicate** of a sentence tells what the subject does, is or has.

My sister likes to play games.

What is a fragment sentence?

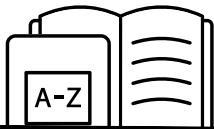
A fragment sentence doesn't have a subject or a predicate. It doesn't make sense when you read it.

At the pool.

What is a complete sentence?

A complete sentence has both a subject and a predicate. It makes sense when you read it.

We went swimming at the pool.

What is a compound sentence?

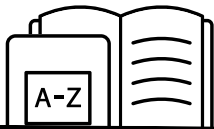
A sentence that has connective words.
Compound sentences are two shorter sentences put together.

I went to the pool and played all day.

What is a run-on sentence?

A sentence that is too long and don't always make sense. It can be split up into more than one sentence to make sense.

We played all day the sun set in the sky.
