

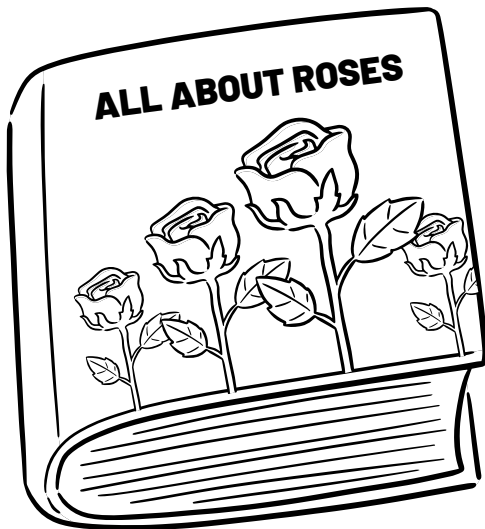

A fact is something true that you can prove with evidence.

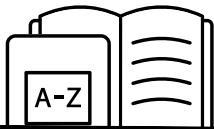


Fact:

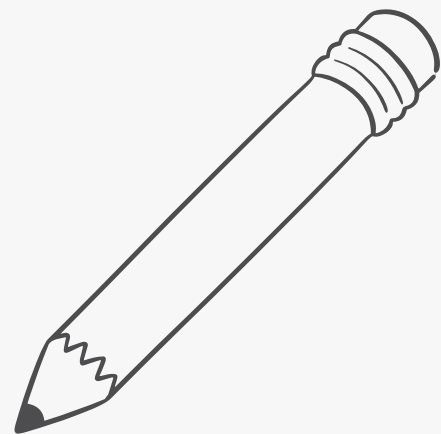
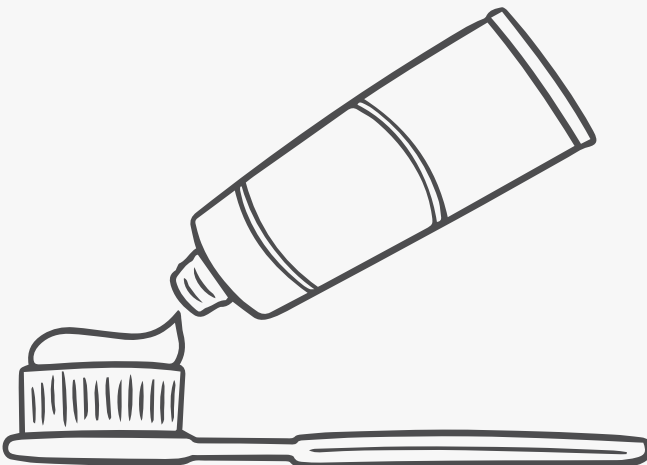
MINERALS

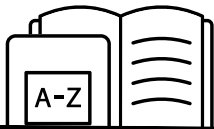
You might be surprised to learn that you use minerals every day. There are minerals in some of the foods that we eat.

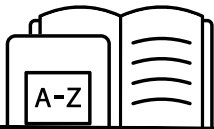

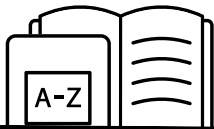

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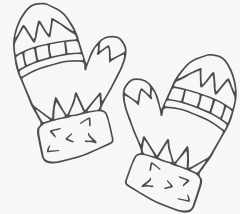

COLD HANDS - WARM HEART



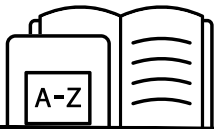
I was born in sunny Florida, but last year my family moved to Minnesota. Mom and Dad thought it would be a good idea to help the Minnesota congregation preach.

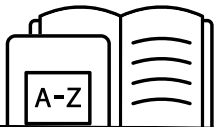

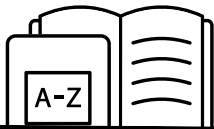

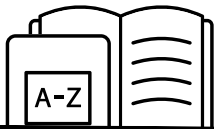
