

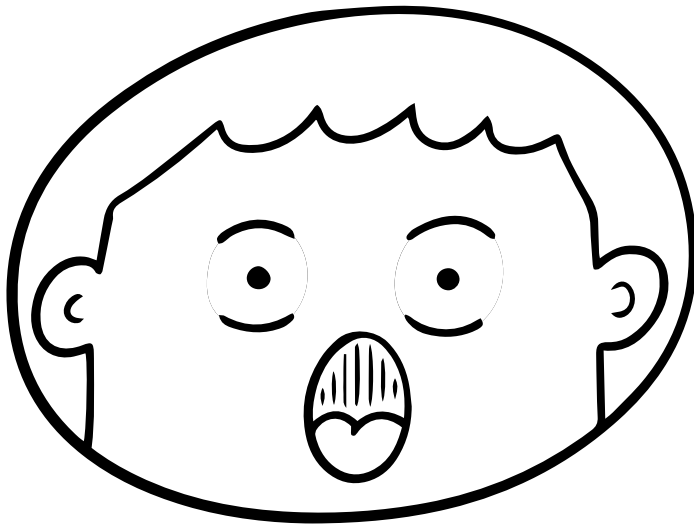

**Interpretive Question**

An interpretive question asks you to look at the clues in the story to figure out the answer.

**How did Billy feel when he saw the cat?**



**clue**



Billy gasped and his eyes widened.

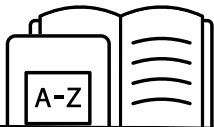
"Fluffy is that really you?"

"I can't believe you made it all the way home Fluffy!" Billy said as he picked the cat up.

**We know that people gasp when they feel surprised.  
So the clue tells us that Billy feels surprised.**

**How do you know?**

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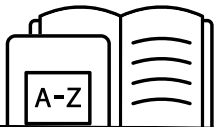
