

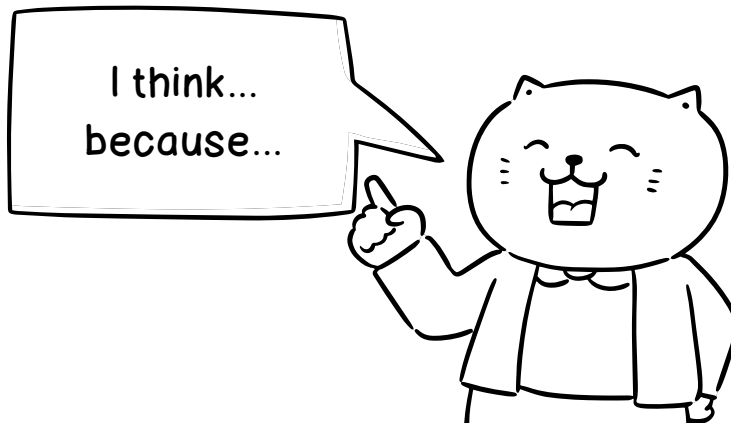

Opinions

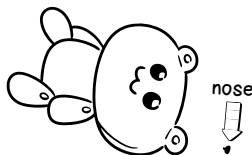
An opinion is what someone thinks about something.



Opinion Questions

You can answer an opinion (or evaluative) question by telling what you think about something you've read. Don't forget to tell why you think that way.

"Gary has a big problem, he dropped his sister's favorite bear and its nose fell off!"

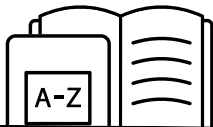


What do you think Gary should do?

- Answer #1: "I think Gary should tell his sister what happened."
- Answer #2: I think Gary should try to fix the bear.
- Answer #3: I think Gary should tell her and try to fix it.



All 3 answers are good
because they give an opinion.

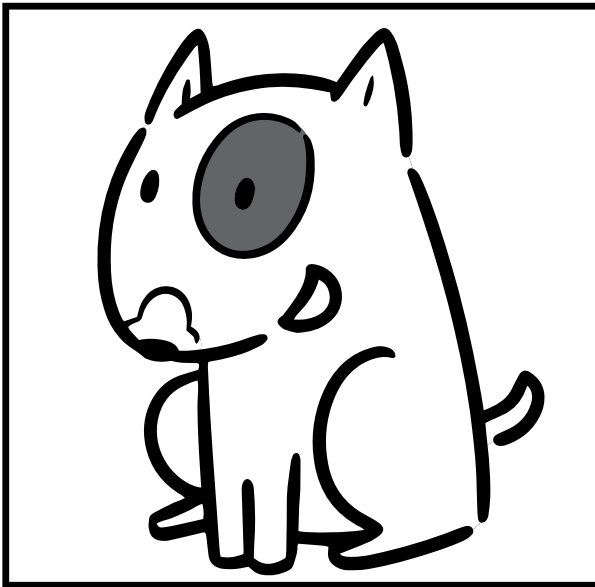


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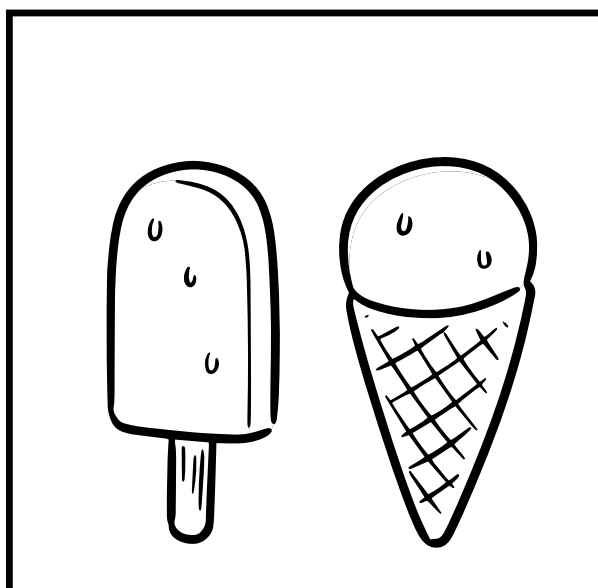

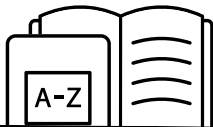

The dress went flying and fell on the kitchen table!

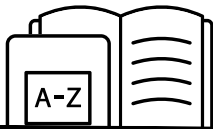
Right into her bowl of vanilla pudding!

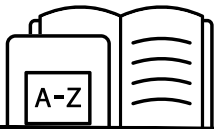
Read the story below and answer the question.

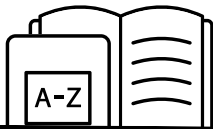
ICE CREAM
