VERBS AND VERBS IN PAST TENSE

Verbs

Verbs are action words that tell what the subject is doing.
When a verb tells what someone or something is doing, it's called
an action verb.

Action Verb

He jumps.

Subject and Verb Agreement

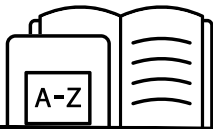
A singular subject must go with a singular verb.
Singular verbs end with **-s** or **-es**.
And a plural subject must go with a plural verb.

Singular Verb

She sings.

Plural Verb

They sing.



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Present Tense, Past Tense, and Future Tense

Present tense verbs tell about what is happening **now**.
Past tense verbs tell about what happened **in the past**.
Future tense verbs tell about what will happen **later, in the future**.

Present Tense

He plays.

Past Tense

He played.

Future Tense

He will play.

Lively Verbs

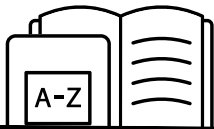
Lively verbs express more. They make our sentences more exciting to read and express what happened in a way that makes it easier for the reader to imagine it.

Regular Verb

The dog followed the squirrel and started barking.

Lively Verb

The dog chased the squirrel and started barking.
