What is a Sentence?

A sentence is a group of words that tells a complete thought that makes sense. A sentence always **begins with a capital letter** and **ends with a punctuation** mark.

Interrogative Sentences:

An **interrogative sentence** asks a **question**.
It ends with a **question mark**.

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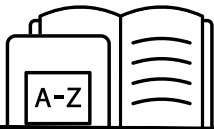
Read each Story. Underline the answer to the question.
