TYPES OF SENTENCES

What is a Sentence?

A sentence is a group of words that tells a complete thought that makes sense. A sentence always **begins with a capital letter** and **ends with a punctuation** mark.

There are two types of sentences:

An **interrogative sentence** is a sentence that asks a question.
A **declarative sentence** is a sentence that tells something.

Declarative:

Jesus walked on the water.

Interrogative:

How did Jehovah save Daniel?

Punctuations Marks go at the end of the sentences.

They help us figure out if a sentence is a question or a statement.
A sentence without punctuation is an **incomplete sentence**.

Interrogative Sentences

A question sentence that ends with a question mark.

Declarative Sentences

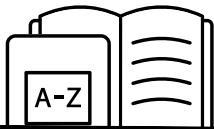
A statement sentence that can end with a period.
