Sentences

A sentence is a group of words that tells a complete thought that makes sense.

Two Types of Sentences:

An **exclamation sentence** is a sentence that expresses a strong feeling.

A **command sentence** is a sentence that tells someone to do something.

Exclamation:	What a nice day!
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Command:	Honor your father and your mother.
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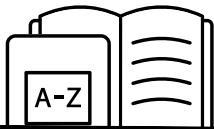
Punctuations Marks go at the end of the sentences.

They help us figure out if a sentence is an exclamation or a command.
A sentence without punctuation is an **incomplete sentence**.

Exclamatory Sentences
A sentence that ends with an exclamation mark.

Imperative Sentences
A command sentence that ends with a period.
